We offer a very accurate and reliable feline TLI test (serum trypsin-like immunoreactivity) which will detect exocrine pancreatic insufficiency (EPI).

This method is exclusive to NationWide Specialist Laboratories.

- High levels of TLI can also indicate increased release of trypsin into the circulation which may indicate pancreatitis. It is very important to sample suspected cases of pancreatitis as early as possible to obtain an accurate diagnosis, as the levels of TLI decrease as the condition progresses.
- Cats being tested for Feline TLI should be fasted for a minimum of 6 hours. An overnight starve is ideal.
- A serum sample should be submitted to the laboratory.
- Feline TLI is run once a week on Thursday.
